

## part II

Results of Activity/Project/Program Implementation by The Department of Social Development and Welfare in Fiscal Year 2008



2.1 The Achievement of Implementing Activities / Projects / Programs by the Department of Social Development and Welfare Based on the Performance Agreement in the Fiscal Year 2008

nevaluation of the Department's performance in the fiscal year 2008 conducted by the Office of the Public Sector Development Commission revealed that, on the whole, it got 4.0373 marks out of 5. The results can be broken down into the following dimensions:

# Dimension 1: Effectiveness of Activities / Projects / Programs as Compared to the Action Plan

To reach the goal of this particular dimension,

10 common indicators were developed by the Ministry
of Social Development and Human Security to be
used by all organizations that are under the Ministry.

Each one of them was assigned to be the host
agency for an indicator or a number of indicators.

Taking all indicators into consideration, the
Department got 2.4654 marks out of 5. As for the 6
indicators under the Department's responsibility as
being the host agency, it got a total of 4.9177 marks out of 5.



For this dimension, the Department got the overall score of 3.8278.

### Dimension 2: Quality of Services

To reach the goal of this particular dimension, the Department made an attempt to improve the quality of its services by providing opportunities for the general public to be involved in sharing views/comments, the actual improvement of services and the follow-up of such improvement. Focus of the improvement was on welfare services for the low-income persons in particular. In addition to that, the direction was given to all agencies under the Department to open up opportunities for people to be involved in improving the quality of services as much as possible. The degree of people participation was divided into the following 5 levels which, on the whole, could be achieved by the agencies:

• There were channels for the inflow of information (100% of the agencies)

- There was a system which views/ comments could be conveyed (100% of the agencies)
- There was a system which put views/ comments into actual implementation (100% of the agencies)



- There were advisors from the general public
   (80.3 % of the agencies)
- There was a monitor and follow-up mechanism (80.3 % of the agencies)

In addition to that, measuring the satisfaction of the client was also done by the National Statistic Office for 3 services/activities, namely access to services and opportunity for older persons to participate in social activities, promotion and support for private-run child care centers and vocational training for women. The overall satisfaction was 86.4%.

For this dimension, the Department got the overall score of 3.845.

### Dimension 3: Efficiency of Activities/Projects/programs



To reach the goal of this particular dimension, focus of the Department was on the proper management of budget especially the disbursement of budget to proceed according to the plan. At the same time, a continued effort was also made to reduce electricity and energy consumption. When compared to the standard index, the Department could save the electricity and energy

consumption and got a total of 3.456 marks. Detailed unit costs were prepared to serve as references for finding ways and means of increasing the Department's efficiency when it concerned the implementation of activities/projects/programs for fiscal year 2008. As for the provision of services for the general public, the Department maintained the standard concerning time spent on processing

6 services. The process of finding prospective adoptive families abroad for Thai children was submitted to the Office of Public Sector Development Commission and subsequently awarded a consolation prize in the category of a process that linked several government agencies

For this dimension, the Department got the overall score of 3.9576.

### Dimension 4: Organization Development

The Department used the quality management criteria for the public sector (which was the tool for developing the quality of management in an organization in order to be up to standard) as a framework for self-assessment and a standard for follow-up and evaluation of the Department's management for the purpose of improving and upgrading the quality of its management. Several indicators were incorporated including knowledge management, information technology management, risk management, transfer of knowledge about indicators and aims from organization to individual level, development of human resource management system.



For this dimension, the Department got the overall score of 4.6.

### 2.2 The Past Performances Implemented by the Department of Social Development and Welfare under the Operation Plan for the Fiscal Year 2008

The implementation of activities/projects/ programs by the Department of Social Development and Welfare under the Operation Plan (2008-2011) for the Fiscal Year 2008 bear the following results which are classified according to the Department's 5 strategic issues:

### Strategic Issue 1: Strengthening Social Protection

To promote the strategic issue of strengthening social protection, the Department of Social Development and Welfare has adopted the strategy to enhance knowledge and family environment suitable for children and youth. The following outputs/activities that link to the strategic issue were achieved.

**Strategic guideline:** Enhancing knowledge and family environment suitable for children and youth

1.1 Output : Knowledge and family environment suitable for children and youth was enhanced.

1.2 Output against target: The output was the result of implementing 3 main activities: strengthening social protection for children and youth, strengthening the process of community child care and promoting and supporting proper child care suitable for the age of each individual child. The overall target was 42,920 persons who were expected to benefit from activities and the actual output was 55,389 persons or 129.05% of the set target. The details are as follows:

Key Activity 1: Strengthening social protection for children and youth - This was done by raising an awareness among families and communities of the importance of child care and child development, encouraging communities to develop suitable learning and recreation areas or centers for children and supporting the organizing



of activities in the learning centers that promote proper child development i.e. activities relating to creative arts, music, sports, training to provide knowledge for families or activities that promoted the IQ and EQ of children using media/ tools for enhancing development as well as virtue and ethics of children. In 2008, there were 19,824 children and youth who were involved in activities and provided with suitable environment or 118% of the set target of 16,800 children and youth.

Key Activity 2: Strengthening the process of community child care - Communities were encouraged to organize activities continuously in learning centers that further enhance child development and to extend the activities to other areas within their district. In 2008, there were 16,359 children and youth who participated in activities or

Key Activity 3: Promoting and supporting proper child care that suits the child age - The actual output was 18,606 persons or 158.07% of the set target of 11,770 persons. The details are as follows:

3.1 Provision of knowledge and skills of early childhood care and development for a total of 8,909 persons who were operators of private-run child care and child welfare institutions, parents or guardians of children who were their clients;

3.2 Better service quality promotion in private-run child care and child welfare institutions involving a total of 9,697 persons.

#### 1.3 Outcome against target :

Communities had learning centers for children which provided them with the opportunity to participate in activities with their families and other community members resulting in warm and close family tie and environment and a healthy child growth that fit relatively well with the child age.

### Strategic Issue 2: Promoting and building the capacity of the target population in making a living

The strategic guidelines adopted by the Department of Social Development and Welfare to promote strategic issue 2 was to promote and build the capacity of the target population in making a living and to promote and provide them with social welfare services.

Strategic guideline 1: Promoting and providing social welfare services for the target population

1.1 Output: The target population were provided with social welfare services which involved producing/implementing the following activities that linked with the strategic issue:

1.1.1 Output against target: The output was the result of implementing 5 main activities: providing welfare services in welfare homes or institutions. providing welfare services in communities, developing the system, form and standard of service providing for each target group, promoting and supporting activities under the Bond of Family Love Project and providing rehabilitation services through the treatment of drug addiction. The overall target was 606,756



persons and the actual output was 1,032,852 persons or 170.23% of the set target. The detailed activities are as follows:

Key Activity 1 : Providing welfare services in welfare homes or institutions - The overall target of this particular activity was 19,302 persons and the actual output was 31,221 persons or 161.75% of the set target. The details are as follows:

1. Institutional care services were provided for children and youth which covered such facilities as reception homes, residential homes, child welfare protection homes, child development and rehabilita tion centers, shelters for families and children for a total of 16,046 persons or 169.97% of the set target of 9,440 persons. Services were available in several forms including:

- 1.1 Provision of welfare services in 29 residential homes, reception homes, child welfare protection homes and vocational training centers for totally 7,755 children and youth from new born babies to 18 years old covering the provision of 4 basic necessities as well as child and youth development in all aspects to prepare them for reintegration with their families and society
- 1.2 Provision of welfare services in 43 shelters for families and children which included temporary accommodation and physical as well as psychological rehabilitation for children and families facing social problems and requiring immediate assistance such that they could lead a normal life in society
- 2. Institutional care services were provided for women in welfare protection and occupational development centers for women. and children facing various social referred to reception homes problems were and welfare protection and occupational development centers for welfare protection. Such institutions were set up according to the Prevention and Suppression of Prostitution B. E. 2539 (1996). There are now totally 4 institutions which offer services covering the provision of 4 basic necessities, education, vocational training and physical rehabilitation. Assistance is also provided to help them reintegrate with their families and society without being lured once again into the vicious circle of human trafficking. The assistance provided includes the organizing of activities or services for clients. In



2008, there were a total of 1,576 women who were provided with assistance or 121.23 % of the set target of 1,300 women.

- 3. Institutional care services were provided for the destitute in 11 reception homes and homes for the destitute. Services such as the provision of 4 basic necessities, physical and psychological rehabilitation and vocational skill development were offered to the homeless, the destitute and beggars who were admitted into the homes. The aims were to enable them to become self-reliant, to lead a normal life in society and to refer them to other concerned agencies for some cases that needed further assistance. There were a total of 8,078 persons who were provided with services or 199.51 % of the set target of 4,049 persons.
- 4. Institutional care services were provided for persons with disabilities in 10 homes for persons with disabilities who had no one to care for or those who had been cared for improperly. Temporary accommodation was also available for person with disabilities who wished to obtain rehabilitation services covering the provision of 4 basic necessities, physical rehabilitation by doctors, education, vocational training, the organizing of recreation and social activities and the preparation of their physical and mental well-being so that they could become



self-reliant and eventually integrate into society as valuable members. There were a total of 5,401 persons with disabilities who were provided with services or 122.39 % of the set target of 4,413 persons with disabilities.

5. Services were provided at the centers for persons with autism, Khon Kaen Province. They included medical services, physical therapy and rehabilitation, preparation of clients for reintegration into families and communities. There were totally 120 persons who were provided with services or 120 % of the set target of 100 persons.

Key Activity 2: Providing welfare services in communities - The overall target of this particular activity was 508,850 persons and the actual output was 821,990 persons or 161.53 % of the set target. The details are as follows:

2.1 Welfare services for children and youth in communities - The aim was to make services available so that children and youth could enjoy a happy life in their families and communities, a good quality of life and be provided with welfare protection. A survey was conducted and assistance was provided for children who were not brought up properly by their families, poor, homeless, abandoned, abused, commercially exploited, children who faced various problems or behaved improperly. Providing welfare services for families and communities was promoted and supported. There were totally 181,554 persons who were provided with services or 107.94 % of the set target of 168,190 persons. Services provided were in several forms as follows:

2.1.1 Children who could not live with their families and children under institutional care were placed in foster or adoptive families. The aim was to help children enjoy a healthy child growth and warm love and care from the new families. Out of the total number of 6,908 children, 3,958 were placed in Thai adoptive families, 450 were placed in adoptive families abroad and 2,500 were placed in foster families respectively.

2.1.2 Welfare services were provided for children living in poor families. The aim was to enhance family security such that it could continue to perform the roles and responsibilities of bringing up their child members properly within the limit of their financial capability. Services available included counseling for parents or guardians concerning child rearing, funding support for scholarships of children. income-generating activities, consumer goods for daily use, school uniforms etc. There were totally126, 882 persons who benefited from services.

2.1.3 Promotion and support was given to the development of a total of 48,266 children by 1,190 private-run child care, child welfare or reception homes in the forms of supplementary food and child development kits with the aim to ensure that they were brought up and developed in suitable places

2.2 Welfare services in communities for lowincome persons - The aim was to ease immediate financial problems and enable the low-income persons to lead their life within the limit of their financial capability. There were totally 523,539 persons who were provided with services or 222.66 % of the set

target of 235,120 persons. Services provided were in several forms as follows:

- 2.2.1 Cash assistance was provided for a total of 337,092 persons from low-income families.
- 2.2.2 A shelter for travelers was available at Dindaeng District and used by a total of 26,325 persons.
- 2.2.3 Temporary accommodation was provided by 4 shelters for the urban poor which served a total of 3,764 persons.
- 2.2.4 In-kind assistance was offered to totally 156,358 persons who encountered problems.
- 2.3 Welfare services in communities for persons facing social problems There were totally 116,897 persons who were provided with services or 110.76 % of the set target of 105,540 persons. Services provided were in several forms as follows:
- 2.3.1 Welfare assistance for 96,341 persons facing social problems
- 2.3.2 Welfare assistance for the return of 6,262 persons in distress to their domicile
- 2.3.3 Welfare and rehabilitation services for 12,226 persons with disabilities
- 2.3.4 Assistive devices for 2,068 persons with disabilities

Key Activity 3: Developing the system, form and standard of service providing for each target group - Focus of the development as well as the monitoring and evaluation was in the following 3 areas:

3.1 The standards of service providing for children under institutional care - The aim was to set and develop the standards, indicators and criteria of services provided for children to be further used by the Department's agencies in rendering services for children. Five standards were developed: the organization/management standard, the personnel



standard, the environment standard, the standard of services and activities for children and the standard of child development based on their potential.

- 3.2 The standards of referring clients or using the forms of referring clients to develop standards, indicators and criteria to be further used by the Department's agencies Four standards were developed: the standard of referring service, the standard of referring tools and equipment, the standard of referring system and the standard of network development.
- 3.3 The internal self-monitoring and evaluation conducted by the Department's agencies The aim was to further develop the standards of service providing in 11 homes for the destitute and 19 homes and vocational rehabilitation centers for persons with disabilities.

Key Activity 4 : Promoting and supporting activities under the Bond of Family Love Project

- The overall target of this particular activity was 78,484 persons and the actual output was 181,095 persons or 230,74 % of the set target. The details are as follows:
- 4.1 A campaign to raise awareness and increase better understanding of a total of 19,749 persons about the implementation of the following activities under the Bond of Family Love Project;





4.1.1 Campaign to promote the Bond of Family Love Project in Bangkok and the other 75 provinces

- 4.1.2 Project outcomes/results were further extended to areas under the Royal Initiate Projects the Cooperative Village Project at San Kampaeng District, Chiang Mai Province and the Huai Sat Yai Cooperative Village at Don Khun Huai, Nong Glub, Klad Nong, Prajuabkirikhan Province
- 4.1.3 Promotion of family and community involvement in welfare activities for the target groups and families (group home activities)
- 4.1.4 Project activities were implemented in Yomarat railway communities
- 4.2 A baseline data system of the target groups and families within the project areas of Bangkok and the other 75 provinces was developed covering a total of 2,411 persons or 100 % of the set target of 2,411 persons.
- 4.3 Promotion of social welfare service providing in various aspects for the target groups in the project areas totaling 158,935 persons:
- 4.3.1 Promotion and support for the work of Sritaweerak Center which was carried out within the area of the Royal Project 904
- 4.3.2 The establishment of the following 2 centers for strengthening the tie of three generations

and weaving the bond of family love which are under the patronage of Her Royal Highness Princess Srirasmi, the Consort of the Crown Prince Maha Vajiralongkorn:

- The center for strengthening the tie of three generations and weaving the bond of family love at Am Paeng, Samut Sakorn Province
- The center for strengthening the tie of three generations and weaving the bond of family love at Bang Sao Thong, Samut Prakarn Province

The implementation of activities under the project on centers for strengthening the tie of three generations and weaving the bond of family love by the following 10 social welfare development centers for older persons, vocational rehabilitation centers for persons with disabilities and residential homes:

- Kok Sri Center for older persons, Muana District which is under service coverage of Khon Kaen Social Welfare Development Center for Older Persons, Khon Kaen Province
- Bang Luang Center for older persons, Bang Barn District which is under service coverage of Wasanavej Social Welfare Development Center for Older Persons, Pranakorn Sri Ayudaya Province
- Yala Center for older persons which is under service coverage of Ban Taksin Social Welfare Development Center for Older Persons, Yala Province
- Thart Thong Center for older persons, Bor Thong District which is under service coverage of Ban Banglamung Social Welfare Development Center for Older Persons, Cholburi Province
- Nang Rong Center for older persons, Nang Rong District which is under service coverage of Ban Burirum Social Welfare Development Center for Older Persons, Burirum Province
- Ra Wai Center for older persons, Muang District which is under service coverage of Phuket

Social Welfare Development Center for Older Persons. Phuket Province

- Mae Taeng Center for older persons, Mae
   Taeng District and Mae Hia Center for Older Persons,

Key Activity 5: Providing rehabilitation services for those who had gone through the drug addiction treatment - Physical, psychological, emotional, social rehabilitation as well as vocational skill development services were provided for the ex-drug addicts who had gone through the drug addiction treatment to prepare them for the return and reintegration with their families, communities and society. There were totally 120 persons who were provided with services or 100 % of the set target of 120 persons.

1.1.2 Outcome against target The target population which were the disadvantaged were provided with assistance such that they could lead their life within the limit of their financial capability and had access to basic social services not less than the standard criteria that had been set.

Output: HIV/AIDS problem - solving
 1.2.1 Output against target The output
 was the result of implementing activities relating to



the provision of HIV/AIDS-related social welfare services for a total of 15,624 persons or 101.52 % of the set target of 15,390 persons. The details are as follows:

- 1. Welfare services for 402 children living with HIV/AIDS or affected by HIV/AIDS in 4 residential homes which offered 4 basic necessities and promoted child development to ensure that they would be provided with proper care, child development and protection of their basic rights
- Welfare services in various forms were available for 14,893 persons living with HIV/AIDS or affected by HIV/AIDS in communities:
- 2.1 Assistance in the form of funding support to start income-generating activities was made available for totally 1,693 women affected by HIV/ AIDS either infected with the disease or husbands died from or infected with the disease, those who were poor, had children to care for, lacked funds to make a living or faced other social problems with the aims to enable them to support themselves and their families financially and to be able to live in communities and society;
- 2.2 Family welfare assistance was provided in the form of cash for a total of 11,200 persons who were infected or affected by HIV/AIDS and their families to ease their problems and enable them to remain with their families;



2.3 Child welfare assistance was provided in the form of cash for a total of 2,000 children who were infected or affected by HIV/AIDS to ease their problems, enable them to live in families and communities without being referred to be under institutional care;

3. Prevention of HIV/AIDS by providing knowledge in families and communities for a total of 329 persons who were in the high-risk group.

#### 1.2.2 Outcome against target

Assistance was provided for the target group of persons who were infected or affected by HIV/AIDS. They, therefore, could lead their life within the limit of their financial capability and had access to basic social services no less than the criteria that had been set.

Strategic guideline 2: Promoting and building the capacity of the target population

1.3 Output: The capacity of the target population was promoted and built.

#### 1.3.1 Output against target

The output was the result of implementing 6 main activities: promoting and developing the capacity of highland communities, promoting and developing the capacity of specific areas, enhancing the capacity and opportunity of persons who registered as being poor, promoting and supporting field-level integrated social welfare service providing, supporting the

organizing of activities that strengthen unity in provinces along the southern borders, promoting and supporting the work of the participatory social service centers. There were totally 862,609 persons who benefited from the implementation of activities

or 100.15 % of the set target of 861,301 persons.

Key Activity 1: Promoting and developing the capacity of highland communities - There were totally 555,453 persons who benefited from the implementation of activities or 100.41 % of the set target of 555,225 persons. The details are as follows:

1.1 The capacity of a total of 540,031 hill tribes living in the highlands was promoted and developed through the implementation of such activities as the preparation of village development plans, basic infrastructure development, support given to education and occupational development, provision of public health services, preparation of community master plans, provision of knowledge (village schools), promotion of employment and income generating activities, the establishment of volunteer work to help persons in distress, promotion of more knowledge, better understanding and greater awareness regarding the roles and responsibilities of being Thai citizens and the importance of living in peace and harmony, coordination among agencies concerned in the promotion of highland development.

1.2 The Buddhist Mission Project was promoted by supporting activities carried out by 300 monks living in 150 ashrams located in 14 northern' and central provinces. The aims were to follow and make use of the teaching of the Lord Buddha as an instrument to promote moral development of the highland population and to serve as networks of social welfare and development service providing in the highlands. The knowledge and skills relating to social welfare service providing of Buddhist monks

working in the project areas were increased. The monks were also prepared to develop a 5-year action plan to ensure that the implementation of activities under the Buddhist Mission would cover all areas within the highlands. In 2008, the Department, in cooperation with the Foundation for Buddhist Mission in Remote and Inaccessible Areas, organized a mass ordination ceremony for a total of 884 children, youth and the hill tribes in general to make merit for HRH Princess Galyani Vadhana Krom Luang Naradhivas Rajanagarindra. On 6 July 2008, the ceremony was held at Wat Bejamaborpit for a total of 284 monks and novices. The remaining 600 monks and novices were ordained in temples in 14 provinces, namely Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Mae Hong Son, Lampang, Lampoon, Prae, Nan, Payao, Tak, Kamphaeng Phet, Phitsanulok, Uthai Thani, Phetchabun and Kanchanaburi.

1.3 Support was given to the Royal Initiated Projects implemented in 7 northern provinces of Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Mae Hong Son, Lampoon, Payao, Kamphaeng Phet, Nan. Project activities included basic infrastructure development, training for highland population relating to farm and non-farm activities as well as social welfare services, promotion and support in the area of agriculture and welfare services for poor hill tribe families to increase the potential of the highlands and the opportunity of the population to be well-prepared for development and be able to make a living on a sustainable and selfsufficiency basis and to promote the conservation of natural resources and environment within the highlands. There were totally 4,610 hill tribes who benefited from the projects.

1.4 The highland community economy waspromoted in the northern and central areas covering14 provinces: Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Mae



Hong Son, Lampang, Lampoon, Prae, Nan, Payao, Tak, Kamphaeng Phet, Phitsanulok, Uthai Thani, Phetchabun and Kanchanaburi. The highland population were provided with knowledge and standard services through various training courses that were designed and conducted in response to the specific needs of the population in each area. As a result, they were equipped with knowledge and skills in other income-generating activities apart from their main economic activities. These activities proceeded in harmony with the local arts and crafts, culture, tradition and wisdom which were area-specific. They included, for example, cloth and rattan weaving, making of silverware products and group formation for ecotourism services. There were totally 2,712 hill tribes who were involved and benefited from the activities.

1.5 There were a total of 6,000 hill tribes whose potential in pursuing highland incomegenerating activities had been developed.

1.6 As for the promotion of security in communities located along the borders, activities carried out included the organizing of village meetings to increase better understanding about the government policy, the preparation of village development plans through the problem census technique, the formulation of youth groups for social



development to serve as networks for assistance to be provided for people facing problems. There were a total of 1,800 hill tribes who participated in the activities.

Key Activity 2: Promoting and developing the capacity of specific areas - Activities that had been implemented were involved with land management, development in self-help land settlements covering occupational promotion and provision of water supplies in self-help land settlement areas for both household consumption and agriculture. There were totally 217,316 persons who benefited from the implementation of activities or 100 % of the set target of 217,316 persons.

Key Activity 3: Enhancing the capacity and opportunity of persons who registered as being poor - Focus was on the organizing of vocational training for those who registered as being poor numbering 15,000 persons or 100 % of the set target of 15,000 persons.

Key Activity 4: Promoting and supporting field-level integrated social welfare service providing - Activities which were implemented in 75 districts of 75 provinces included the organizing of thought-provoking training for personnel of tambon (sub-district) administrative organizations, workshops, people forums, the support for social welfare activities

and the producing of learning kits. Activities covered a total of 15,550 persons or 103.66 % of the set target of 15,000 persons.

Key Activity 5 : Supporting the organizing of activities that strengthen unity in the provinces along the southern border - Activities that were carried out included leadership promotion, the organizing of local/village forum, occupational promotion and vocational training based on the philosophy of sufficiency economy, infrastructure development and promotion of recreation activities. There were a total of 8,970 persons who benefited from the activities or services or 102.39 % of the set target of 8,760 persons.

### Key Activity 6: Promoting and supporting the work of the participatory social service centers

- Activities included the organizing of forums where the potential of communities can be identified, thoughtprovoking forums, support for community meetings to select the centers' committee members and support for activities of the centers. There were 50,320 persons who were involved in activities or 100.64 % of the set target of 50,000 persons.

#### 1.3.2 Outcome against target

The target groups within the target areas could make a living, develop financial security for their families and be provided with basic infrastructure services to build capacity for themselves, their families, communities and population in nearby communities. In addition to that, the process of people participation has been developed and support has been given by the public sector in an effort to render social welfare services to help the disadvantaged within society.

1.4 Output: The target groups were provided with knowledge and occupational development.

#### 1.4.1 Output against target

The output was the result of implementing 3

main activities: providing knowledge and occupational development in institutions; organizing vocational training and developing the skill of group formation and; promoting and implementing social development based on the philosophy of sufficiency economy. There were totally 64,792 persons who benefited from the implementation of activities or 103.83 % of the set target of 62,400 persons. The details are as follows:

Key Activity 1: Providing knowledge and occupational development in institutions - Vocational training was organized for women and persons with disabilities in residential homes. The total number of persons provided with services was 6,574 or 147.23 % of the set target of 4,465 persons. The details are as follows:

- 1.1 Vocational training was organized for women in 8 welfare and vocational training centers for women. A total of 6,072 women and young girls who were poor, faced social problems, deprived of opportunity to pursue higher education and unemployed were provided with vocational training, vocational skill development and quality of life improvement services to further enhance their status and employment and income opportunities to support themselves and their families.
- 1.2 Vocational training was provided for persons with disabilities in 8 vocational training centers for persons with disabilities. A total of 502 persons with disabilities were provided with vocational training and vocational skill development to enable them to make a living, earn income and eventually become self-reliant.

Key Activity 2: Organizing vocational training and developing group formation skills-Vocational training was organized and the skill of group formation was developed for the target groups by promoting the effort to set up groups and providing knowledge relating to occupational development with the aim to open up opportunities for employment and income. There were totally 41,900 persons who benefited from the provision of services or 100 % of the set target of 41,900 persons. The details are as follows:

- 2.1 There were various forms of services with regard to vocational training and development of group formation skills provided for a total of 37,900 persons. They were as follows:
- 2.1.1 Vocational training under the Building New Life for Rural Women The 88-day curriculum was developed and used nationwide to benefit rural women who lacked opportunity to pursue higher education, those who were laid off or unemployed or poor to equip them with knowledge in response to local market demand. The training courses were organized for a total of 15,000 trainees covering such subjects as blanket making, traditional cloth weaving, processing of textile products etc.
- 2.1.2 Support given to group formation for income-generating activities through training The aim was to encourage a total of 2,000 female trainees who had undergone vocational training to formulate groups and engage in activities in their own locality that would serve as secure and sustainable sources of income for themselves and their families.
- 2.1.3 Promotion of short-term vocational skill development Vocational knowledge and skills of 20,900 school-age children and youth were enhanced to provide them with employment opportunities and alternatives, enable them to earn supplementary income for their families and make use of their leisure time productively.
- 2.2 The potential of the target groups relating to occupations was developed. A total of 4,000

persons who were unemployed were provided with training to develop their vocational skills that responded to their needs and could be further used for generating employment and income in the fields of agriculture, food processing, weaving and making of art, handicraft and embroidery products.

Key Activity 3: Promoting and implementing social development based on the philosophy of sufficiency economy - There were totally 16,318 persons who benefited from activities that were implemented or 101.76 % of the set target of 16,035 persons. The details are as follows:

3.1 Sufficiency economy was promoted by providing a total of 3,736 persons with knowledge relating to occupational development based on the philosophy of sufficiency economy and group formation for employment and income. Services were available in several forms as follows:

3.1.1. The Royal Initiate Project at the Cooperative Villages of Huai Sat Yai, Hub Ka Pong, Don Khun Huai, Nong Plub Klad Klung in the 2 provinces of Prajuab Kirikan and Petchburi - The project was initiated by His Majesty the King to help poor farmers who were project members by providing them with land where they could live and make a living and improving their quality of life economically and socially. There were totally 1,530 farmers who benefited from the project which was a joint effort between public and private sectors.

3.1.2 The Royal Initiate Project at San Pa Tong Cooperative Village, San Pa Tong District, Chiang Mai Province - Similar to the abovementioned project, it was initiated by His Majesty the King to help poor farmers who were project members by providing them with land where they could live and make a living and improving their quality of life economically and socially. There were totally 1,206

3 ) farmers who benefited from the project which was a joint effort between public and private sectors.

3.1.3 The project to develop and run a campaign to promote the use of vetiver grass -It is the project initiated by His Majesty the King with the aim to promote growing of vetiver grass as a preventive measure against soil erosion in planting or sloping areas. There were a total of 1,000 farmers who were involved in the project.

3.2 Sufficiency economy was piloted by organizing meetings to integrate the work of 5 partners involved, preparing the people for their participation, providing a forum where key concepts and understanding could be further enhanced, developing the capacity of community leaders to extend the results obtained from using the recommended techniques, supporting activities that contributed to or proceeded consistently with the philosophy of sufficiency economy and producing education kits to disseminate relevant knowledge and information. There were totally 12,159 persons who were involved.

3.3 The Coordinating Centers were set up for the Royal Initiate projects at San Pa Tong Cooperative Village in Chiang Mai Province and Huai Sat Yai Cooperative Village in Prajuab Kirikan Province with a total of 400 persons who were involved.

#### 1.4.2 Outcome against target

Vocational skills of the disadvantaged women. persons with disabilities and the target groups in communities were promoted and developed resulting in better income to support themselves and their families on the basis of sufficiency economy.

The guideline adopted by the Department of Social Development and Welfare in order to proceed with this strategic issue was to strengthen the

# Strategic Issue 3: Building the capacity to prevent and protect the target population against social risks

capacity for prevention and protection of the target population against social risks which was under the strategy to strengthen the ability to prevent and protect persons who were affected by social problems and risks. The following projects which linked to this strategic issue were implemented:

**Strategic guideline**: Building the capacity to prevent and protect persons affected by social problems and risks



### 1. 2 Output / project against target :

The output/project consisted of 3 main activities: preventing and dealing with the problem of human trafficking; providing support for the learning of how to prevent, assist and protect woman and child victims of human trafficking and; rehabilitating and building the capacity of the destitute to protect them from being lured into becoming victims of human trafficking. There were totally 128,191 persons who benefited from project implementation or 121.49 % of the set target of 104,380 persons. The details are as follows:

Key Activity 1: Preventing and dealing with the problem of human trafficking - Project activities were carried out and involved a total of 123,122 persons or 120.25 % of the set target of 102,380 persons. The detailed project implementation is as follows:

- 1.1 Coordination and organizing of training/ workshop/seminar to prevent the problem of human trafficking for a total of 7,286 persons
- 1.2 Training to provide knowledge that would safeguard the target groups against human trafficking



- This was done by organizing activities that would provide knowledge and disseminate information to the high-risk youth on how to prevent themselves from being lured into sex trade and to students, parents or guardians, community leaders and the general public on how to prevent themselves from being lured into the vicious cycle of human trafficking. The aims were to prevent the problem of prostitution especially in the high-risk youth group and to encourage people within society to be involved in preventing the problem. There were totally 110,496 participants who participated in the training.
- 1.3 Assistance for 532 victims of human trafficking who were Thais, non-Thais and persons whose nationality could not be identified
- 1.4 Capacity building for the target group totally 6,180 persons to prevent them from being lured and becoming victims of human trafficking by organizing short-term vocational training courses to open up employment and income opportunities so that they could support themselves financially and be able to live with their families

Key Activity 2: Providing support for the

learning of how to prevent, assist and protect woman and child victims of human trafficking-

Six welfare protection and occupational development centers served as learning centers, sites of study visit and pilot organizations for complete social welfare service providing for woman and child victims of human trafficking.

Key Activity 3: Rehabilitating and building the capacity of the destitute or homeless to protect them from being lured into becoming victims of human trafficking - Vocational training and knowledge concerning the rights and opportunities for making a living was provided for 3,697 persons who were the destitute or homeless to enable them

to be prepared for the return and reintegration with their families and communities.

## 1.3 Outcome against target

The work of all concerned organizations at both national and international levels has been integrated and coordination has been maintained to provide assistance in several forms for woman and child victims of human trafficking which were both systematic and efficient. Such cooperation prevented the high-risk youth and also the victims from being re-trafficked.

The strategic guideline was adopted by the Department of Social Development and Welfare to promote strategic issue 4 which involved

# Strategic Issue 4: Building the capacity of older persons and families to wards self - reliance

building the capacity of older persons and families towards self-reliance which was under the strategy to promote and support social welfare service providing and participation of older persons in social activities. The outputs/activities that linked to this strategic issue are as follows:

**Strategic guideline:** Promoting and supporting the provision of social welfare services and participation of older persons in social activities

1.1 Output: The capacity of the target population was enhanced and developed contributing to the promotion of strong family institution.

1.1.1 Output against target The output was the result of implementing 2 main activities: promoting the organizing of social activities for older persons and providing services in social welfare development centers for older persons. There were totally133,990 older persons who benefited from



services or activities provided for them or 164.14 % of the set target of 81,630 persons. The details are as follows:

Key Activity 1: Promoting the organizing of social activities for older persons - There were 47,178 older persons participated in activities or 157.26 % of the set target of 30,000 persons. The details are as follows:

- 1.1 Preparation of older persons in communities before entering the threshold of aging population The aim was to enable people in communities to be well-prepared before the age of 60. They were totally 16,757 older persons who were provided with knowledge and better understanding about changes that would take place physically, mentally and emotionally when a person was getting older. As a result, they should be able to adjust attitudes and relationships with others, become well-informed and live the life of an older person that suited him or her and changing situation.
- 1.2 The organizing of activities that strengthened the relationship among family members A total of 21,095 older persons and their family members participated in recreation activities that promoted better knowledge and understanding about each other, the ability of people from different generations to adjust and live together in peace and happiness and subsequently the ability of older persons to remain with their families.
- 1.3 Promotion of people participation in housing improvement of older persons Community members were encouraged to be involved in improving, repairing or adjusting the environment or houses where older persons lived such that it became safer, more aging friendly and more convenient to move around and reach all parts of houses and also places where activities for older persons were organized.
- 1.4 Provision of services for 2,624 older persons by Muang Mai-Bang Pli Social Welfare Development Center for Older Persons.

Key Activity 2: Providing services in social welfare development centers for older persons
- There were 86,773 older persons who were provide with services or 168.11 % of the set target of 51,630 persons. The details are as follows:

- 2.1 Provision of services in 12 social welfare development centers for older persons Each center would play several roles and serve a variety of functions including being an information center on social welfare, a training and development center, a learning center, an institutional type of welfare service center for older persons, a welfare service center for older persons in communities and a counseling/referral service center. There were totally 1,470 older persons who were provided with services.
- 2.2 Provision of services for older persons in communities Various activities were organized for a total of 85,323 older persons living with their families in communities.

## 1.1.2 Outcome against target

A good relationship had been developed between older persons and other family members. Communities were aware of the importance of older persons and involved in the organizing of activities for older persons. In addition, a new approach to social welfare service providing for older persons, which had been developed, served as a model for other organizations in communities or areas.

1.2 Output: Older persons were provided with opportunities to make use of their valuable knowledge and experiences to benefit the general public and to earn income for themselves.

#### 1.2.1 Output against target

The output was the result from implementing one main activity which involved promoting the use of older persons' wisdom. There were totally 14,164 persons who were involved in activities or 202.34 % of the set target of 7,000 persons. The details are as follows:

Key Activity 1: Promoting the use of older persons' wisdom - There were totally 14,164 persons who were involved in the activity or 202.34 % of the

set target of 7,000 persons. The details of activity are as follows:

- 1.1 Promotion of the community value with regard to cash spending for the welfare of older persons in communities The aim was to provide older persons with the knowledge on cash management and the value of reducing cash spending and increasing cash income which would accumulate and become a source of funding support for their own welfare in the future. There were a total of 7,602 persons who were involved.
- 1.2 Encouragement and support given to older persons to make use of their wisdom to create employment and income opportunities The aim was to provide an opportunity for older persons to spend their leisure time productively by passing their valuable knowledge, experience and wisdom to communities. There were a total of 5,234 persons who were involved.

1.3 Building the capacity of older persons in using their wisdom - The aim was to develop the capacity of older persons to be equipped with knowledge about social welfare and be provided with alternatives of how to contribute the knowledge and experience that they had to benefit the society at large. There were a total of 1,328 persons who were involved.

## 1.2.2 Outcome against target

The capacity of older persons was built socially and economically. They had a chance to use their knowledge, experience and wisdom to benefit their society and themselves regarding income for themselves, their families and communities.

The strategic guideline was adopted by the Department of Social Development and Welfare to promote strategic issue 5 which involved developing the system of social development and welfare

# Strategic Issue 5: Developing the system of social development and welfare networking

networking which was under the strategy to promote and support participation of local communities and local areas in social activities. The outputs/activities that linked to this strategic issue are as follows:

Strategic guideline: Promoting and supporting participation by local communities and local areas in social activities

- 1.1 Output: The capacity of networks was built and developed.
- 1.2 Output against target The output was the result of implementing 3 main activities:



strengthening networks at tambon (sub-district) level; enhancing the working mechanism among networks and; monitoring and strengthening the roles and performances of networks. There were totally 1,741 networks that were involved in activities or 124.70 % of the set target of 1,263 networks. The details are as follows:

Key Activity 1: Strengthening networks at tambon (sub-district) level - The aim was to promote and encourage people in the target areas to form themselves into social development organizations and be involved in the provision of social welfare. In so doing, systematic linkages with local administrative organizations were maintained and local population had greater access to social development and welfare services which were available more thoroughly and met the set target. The activity was carried out in a total of 603 tambons.

Key Activity 2: Enhancing the working mechanism among networks - The activity involved developing a mechanism for coordinating, maintaining linkages, promoting the integration of services and exchange of experiences among social development and human security networks at district level. It also involved support given to social development and human security networks at tambon or sub-district

level to strengthen the capacity of networks and enable them to perform continuously. The working mechanism of a total of 63 networks had been enhanced.

Key Activity 3: Monitoring and strengthening the roles and performances of networks - The activity involved the monitoring and strengthening of the roles of social development and human security networks at tambon or sub-district level such that they could form the relationship both horizontally and vertically, promote linkages both internally and externally and build the capacity to proceed continuously with activities which were related to social development and welfare and accepted by local communities/ areas. The roles of a total of 1,705 networks were strengthened.

## 1.3 Outcome against target

Tambon-level networks had the capacity to work and be involved in the implementation of social development and welfare. There was a working mechanism among networks at district level to integrate the plans that linked with those of the tambon administrative organizations.

## The implementation of the Official Information Act B.E.2540 (1997) for the fiscal year 2008

the fiscal year 2008, the following activities were implemented by the Department of Social Development and Welfare in compliance with the Official Information Act of 1997.

- 1. An official information board was set up under the Department of Social Development and Welfare to supervise and ensure that performance by the Department's Official information Center proceed in accordance with the Official Information Act of 1997
- 2. An official information center was established in the library of the Department which is located on the 3rd floor of Building 2. The center which had a clear sign board indicating its location served as a place where services relating to provision of information were made available to the general public. The center also gave advice to people who sought public information service, updated and improve d the list or index of information to be more systematic to facilitate more convenient searching of information.
- 3. Action taken by the Department of Social Development and Welfare with regard to official information was as follows:
  - 3.1 Published information according to Section 7 (1) (2) (3) in the Royal Gazette, Volume 121, Chapter 117 (Ngor) dated 30 December 204;
  - 3.2 Prepared information according to Section 7 (1) (2) (3) and (4) which was classified and put in a filing system to be further studied by the general public at the official information center;
  - 3.3 Made information according to Section 9 Available for public examination with information being grouped and filed in accordance with each bracket of Section 9 and disseminated some of the information on the Department's website www.dsdw.go.th with a total of 455 viewers who were provided with information;
  - 3.4 Action was taken in compliance with Section 23 (3) concerning personal information by publishing in the royal Gazette, Volume 121, Special Chapter 134 (Ngor) dated 8 December 2004
  - 4. Information relating to the right to access official information was disseminated as follows:
    - 4.1 Ran a public relation campaign though various media including publishing in the journal of the Department of Social Development and Welfare, making direct contact with people in each area to talk and provide knowledge about official information, organizing exhibitions and using community radio broadcasting.
    - 4.2 Opened to views and comments or suggestions of the people concerning channels where information could be passed on i.e. through a web board or a suggestion box and made use of such comments/ suggestions/views collected for further consideration with regard to the management of information disclosure or official information service.
  - 5. There was systematic information disclosure by designating officials in charge of implementing the relating to official information on particular. The Department's top-level administrators gave priority and made an effort to ensure that action would be strictly taken in compliance with the law i.e. reviewed guidelines as specified by the law, provided knowledge about the official Information Act of 1997 through the organizing of seminars and training for the Department's personnel to enable them to be equipped with knowledge and better understanding and to know how to act properly when it comes to officials information
